The Crossroads Renewable Energy Project is expected to create **188 full-time equivalent jobs** during construction.

We are currently assessing the feasibility of a

150 MW solar project in Long County, Georgia.



The Crossroads Renewable Energy Project is expected to provide an estimated one-time pulse of economic activity to Long County during its construction phase supporting **\$1.7 million in associated wages** and benefits and **\$11.5 million in economic output**.

In addition to the jobs created during construction,

we'll be hiring to fill three to five long-term careers

in operations and maintenance.



Our solar projects are **safe and quiet.** Panels are secured to posts that are driven into the ground **without concrete.** This not only reduces impacts on the land but also makes for simple land restoration at the end of the project's life.



Solar projects provide **meaningful economic value** through tax revenue and job creation without a costly burden on public services and infrastructure (i.e., roads or water access).



The Crossroads Renewable Energy Project will feature a dual-use design, allowing for the continuation of on-site agricultural activities. This includes **building upon active apiary leases** to encourage important **pollinator activity in the area** in an effort to enhance the productivity of the site and neighboring land.



When a solar project's life is complete, the project is removed, **the site is returned to its original condition**, and the majority of the **components are recycled**.



BrightNight develops projects to **minimize effects on natural and community resources** and works closely with federal, state, and local agencies that oversee these resources. **Stormwater drainage** on the Crossroads Renewable Energy Project will be designed in accordance with Long County, Georgia Environmental Protection Division and Soil and Water Conservation Commission requirements.
