BrightNight is a renewable power company delivering safe, reliable, and innovative solutions around the world. We're very pleased to be working in the Anaconda community to bring a renewable power project to the former site of the Anaconda Copper Mining Company smelter.

Transforming a superfund site into a clean renewable power project is a model clean energy leadership; and while the environmental benefits of renewable power projects are exciting, many of our community partners are surprised to learn about the significant economic benefits generated through tax revenue, job creation, and the use of local vendors for construction and operation.

Our Progress

To date, we have carefully studied the project's location, examined the economic impact of our project, and are beginning the local permitting process. Once permitting is complete, we will move into construction, and eventually begin the long-term operation. Unlike most renewable power companies, BrightNight is the long-term owner/operator of its projects. Why is this important? Because our development work is not simply focused on the project; we consider how our work will impact the overall community, the ways our work might support community economic development goals, and how we can effectively address community questions throughout the life of the project. Project Features

Utilizes land not suitable for food production, housing, or recreation

200 Megawatts (MW) of clean renewable energy generation; enough electricity to power 46,000 homes

\$110M in Anaconda Deer Lodge County tax revenue over the life of the project

Creates 250 construction jobs and 5 permanent O&M jobs

High-value infrastructure that won't require water during normal operations

The solar project will be paired with a battery storage system to provide clean power even when the sun isn't shining

Montana-generated electricity reduces dependency on electricity imports enabling more local economic growth
