We are currently assessing the feasibility of a **400 MW solar project** in Brantley and Wayne Counties, Georgia.

The Pepper Hammock Project is expected to create **350-400 direct, indirect and induced jobs during construction.**



Our solar projects are **safe and quiet.** Panels are secured to posts that are driven into the ground without concrete. This not only reduces impacts on the land but also makes for simple **land restoration at the end of the project's life.**



Solar projects provide **meaningful economic value** through tax revenue and job creation without a costly burden on public services and infrastructure (i.e., roads or water access).



When a solar project's life is complete, the project is removed, the **site is returned to its original condition**, and the majority of the **components are recycled.**



BrightNight leads the industry in its commitment to sustainable land use practices. For each project, we look for ways to integrate **eco-friendly features** such as livestock grazing areas, apiaries, and pollinator habitats with the greatest benefit to the land and the lowest impact on its resources.
